Juliet is the 8 month old daughter of Mitch & Brandi Pauling. She was diagnosed at 16 weeks with a rare condition called gastroschesis. While she was developing, her intestines formed outside of her body causing her to have immediate surgery after birth. She spent 72 days in the Sioux Falls NICU while she recovered from her first surgery, & had another surgery to take out a 10 cm section of her small intestine. She was discharged from the NICU early October, but sadly went back to the PICU for a bacterial overgrowth where she spent another week for treatment. In February she was admitted back to the hospital for failure to thrive, which is an unknown condition. She spent 2 weeks on the pediatric floor in Sioux Falls until she was transferred to the University Of Minnesota for imbalanced electrolytes & possible kidney issues. After 5 weeks at the University of Minnesota they have not been able to find the cause. She has a PICC line in her arm so they can draw labs without poking her, & she also gets TPN through this line as well. Juliet also has a Gtube on her side that allows her medications & formula to be put right into her stomach. She will go home with the PICC line & TPN as it gives her all the nutrients she needs to grow and thrive. The doctors have worked hard to find the issue but to no avail. There is not a timeline for how long she will have a PICC line, be in TPN, or her Gtube. We are hopeful that someday she'll be able to no longer need these extra items to help her thrive in life.
